

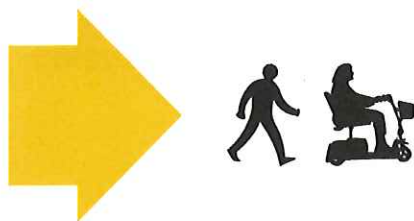
# The Countryside Code

The arrows show the legal and recorded rights of way for different user groups

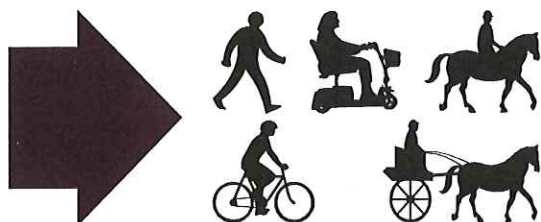
### Footpath
